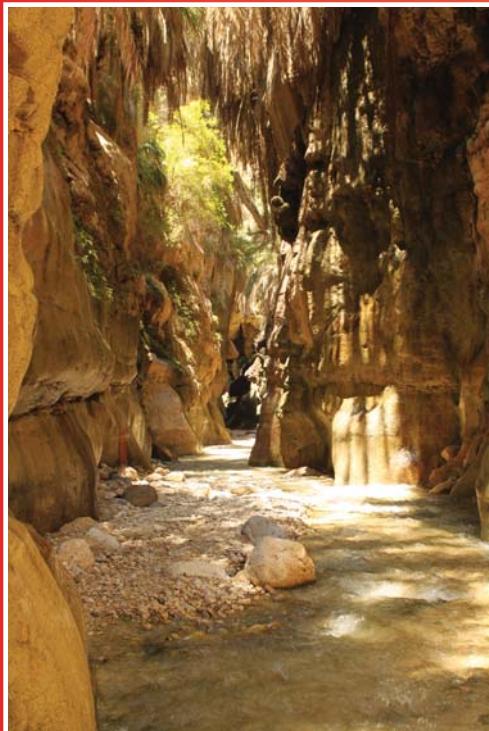
How important is Arabic?

Arabic is at the top of the list of five languages that the U.S. Department of State deems to be "critical languages". It is the official language in 26 countries and the 5th most spoken language in the world with 300 million native speakers. There are over 1.6 million Arabs and approximately 6 million Muslims living in the United States. However, Arabic remains one of the least spoken languages among westerners.



The Academic Program: What to expect
