## **TRANSPORTATION**

The closest airport to Shawnee is the Will Rogers World Airport in Oklahoma City (OKC). It is about a 50 minute drive. If you fly into Tulsa, you would be driving about 2.5 hours. OKC seems to be the best airport to fly into.

No ground transportation is available other than renting a car. The drive is fairly simple. As you come out of Will Rogers Airport, follow Terminal Drive south to I-40. (Terminal Drive turns into S. Meridian). Go east on I-40 about 45 miles. You'll want to take the second or third Shawnee exit, depending on which hotel you stay in.

The OBU campus is the second Shawnee exit (Exit 185 for Kickapoo Street). Turn right on Kickapoo and travel south for approx. 2 miles. Turn left on MacArthur. Reserved parking will be available to the west of the library (on your left between the library and Raley Chapel)

OBU will provide a shuttle service from area hotels to campus on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

## **SCHEDULE**

Campus signs will direct you to parking that will be reserved in the surrounding lots.

Early registration will begin at 5:30 p.m. with a <u>new</u> Welcome session for all early arrivals at 7:00 p.m. on the OKBU campus.

CGE EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE: There will be a CGE Executive Committee meeting and dinner at 5:00 p.m. on Wednesday evening on the campus with the location TBA. At 7:00 p.m. the Executive Committee will join the early arrivals at a Welcome Ceremony.
